



Instructions for your group - Laser Tag

1. It is suggested to all players that on the day they wear an old pair of jeans/track suit bottoms and an old sweatshirt or jumper in dark colours, and bring an old pair of gloves with them. Ideally old clothes just in case they get muddy on the day.
2. Footwear is **not** supplied by TASKFORCE. It is strongly recommended that all players wear an old pair of flat soled shoes or boots with a thick tread, and if possible with good ankle support. The terrain on site is uneven and on occasions quite muddy, in wet weather football or rugby boots provide excellent grip.
3. Players should bring with them a change of clothes, especially in the winter months or if rainfall is expected. If it has been wet or a player has got particularly muddy they may wish to change in to dry/clean clothes before their journey home.
4. No equipment, pyrotechnics or ammunition, other than that provided by TASKFORCE may be used on site. Anyone found to be in possession of any unauthorised equipment, whether it be a firework or a tactical nuclear weapon, will have them confiscated until the end of the day
5. The balance of any outstanding game fee should be paid on arrival, we accept cash, credit or debit card. Cheques are not accepted unless by prior arrangement.
6. We cannot be held responsible for any valuables lost on site, and suggest you leave any items of value at home.
7. All participants whether playing, as a spectator, or otherwise will be expected to adhere to all safety rules and instructions given on the day. Anyone who fails to do so will be asked to leave the site for their own safety and the safety of others.
8. **Alcoholic beverages** will **not** be brought to or consumed on the site, except with the prior agreement of the TASKFORCE organisers. Anyone suspected of being under the influence of alcoholic drink or drugs will be refused admission
9. Any player under the age of 18, must have a TASKFORCE entry form signed by a parent or guardian. Entry will not be permitted to TASKFORCE without a signed entry form. If you require a form, please contact us on 02920 593900

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ORGANISERS

1. Collect a deposit of £10 from each of the players in your group. Detailed on your booking form will be the date when your deposit is due at the Taskforce office, please ensure your deposit reaches the office by the due date, bookings are not confirmed until the deposits have been received.
2. If deposits are not received by the dates detailed on your booking form Taskforce reserve the right to release your places to others wishing to book on this date
3. Please ensure your group arrive on site by the time specified on your booking form - The safety briefing will start promptly at the start time confirmed on your booking letter, any one arriving late will miss the first game and a subsequent safety briefing will be held during this period. When you arrive on site please make your way up the hill, and at the top of the hill turn left into the laser tag area. Follow the signs to reception.
4. Please notify us of any significant change in the number of places you have booked, and please notify us immediately should you wish to cancel your game, this will enable us to release your places for any one else wishing to book on this date.
5. Ensure all members of your group are aware of the directions to the site, our mobile number on site is 07976 200159 should any one wish to contact us on the day.
6. Payment of deposits can be by credit or debit card over the phone or on line.
7. Late payment of invoices will incur a 10% surcharge for every month or part month they are overdue

TASKFORCE CONDITIONS OF BUSINESS

1. Alcoholic beverages will not be brought to, or consumed on the site, except with prior agreement of TASKFORCE organisers. Anyone suspected of being under the influence of alcoholic drink or drugs will be refused admission.
2. Participants will conform to all safety regulations in force
3. Any participant can be required by the TASKFORCE organisers to sit out or to leave the site, if he/she is even slightly under the influence of drink or drugs, not obeying safety regulations, assaulted or threatened to assault an organiser, judge or other players or for any reason that the TASKFORCE organisers (in their sole discretion) judge to make him/her unsuitable to play/continue to play. No refund of fees will be due under such circumstances.
4. Participants agree to play at their own risk, recognising that there are natural hazards – including, but not limited to, fallen trees, sharp branches, rabbit holes etc. Participants will be required to sign an entry form acknowledging the above before commencing play.
5. Participants must be over 18 years of age unless prior authorisation has been given by a parent or guardian – Players under 18 will not be permitted to play without an entry form signed by a parent or guardian.
6. Deposits are non-refundable for players who fail to turn up on the day booked.
7. Strong boots or shoes should be worn, footwear is not provided the ground can be slippery and is uneven in places
