



Safety Brief – Paintball

- Due to Covid 19 you are required to keep to a safe 2m distance between all players and staff and keep within Government guidelines
- The details provided to us on your entry form, may be used for track and trace purposes if required by local authority.
- Within the safe area, you will find, toilets – There will be spray cleaner and wipes so that you can sanitise before and after use. These will be cleaned regularly throughout the day. Queuing system is in place outside and keep your distance.
- You will be allocated a spot for your use within our safe area, and on arrival will be given a customer number and a corresponding numbered place for your kit/equipment which will be exclusively yours for the session
- Your gun will be located at your number in the gun rack and must be placed back in the same slot when you return back from your games.
- Kitchen is closed due to Covid 19 restrictions until further notice. Please bring any food you require with you. Drinks and chocolates are available for sale.
- The safe area now contains a one way system that is signposted, please keep to the one way system as directed.
- When games start, the safe area is then the only area within the woodlands that you can remove your goggles and must remain on at all times.
- Goggles must remain on whilst in the gun rack.
- Please do not shoot anyone at under 3.5 metres, give that person the option to surrender. Marshals will remove that person from the game. Anyone shooting at less than 3.5m will be removed from the game due to unsafe play.
- Do not shoot at anyone's head and face.
- No Physical contact, no climbing trees or structures, no cheating
- Don't discharge your gun whilst walking down the road to and from game fields. Do not shoot another players. Keep your distance whilst walking to and from game fields.
- No dry firing guns (pulling the trigger when you have run out of paint pellets)
- No blind firing guns
- No guns allowed inside the safe area
- If you are caught lifting your goggles outside the safe area you will lose your team 10 points and sit out the next game. If you are caught twice for your own safety, you will be removed from the games completely.
- Individual games will be explained on the game field by the marshal. Please keep your 2m distance when having this briefing.
- Paint pellets lying on the floor should not be picked up, as the gelatine shell swells in the damp and will block your gun and hopper.
- Paint pellets that hit you but don't break do not count as a hit. Carry on playing
- A pellet that breaks and leaves a paint splat will eliminate you from the game.
- Do not shoot wildlife or marshals
- When you are hit, lift your gun arm in the air and leave the field, the marshals will tell you where to stand until the end of the game, please keep your goggles on and your distance from other players.
